Our Vision

Kids First envisions a world where adults place the well being of *kids first*.

Boyz 2 Men Day Camp June 22 - August 28, 2009

A disproportionate number of African-American boys live in single parent homes, led by women, with no positive male role models. They have no one to teach them what it takes to become a man. Forty-three percent of African-American students in California drop out of school before graduating high school. This leads to incarceration, unemployment, homelessness, and death.

To address this problem Kids First launched Boyz 2 Men Day Camp in June 2008. The camp meets Monday through Friday. Each day has a different theme and focus.

The Village Theme

- Designed to teach about the African-American community
- The young men will experience history by visiting community icons
- The focus is to demonstrate African-American history and values

Volunteerism Theme

- Designed to teach African-American young men to give back to their communities
- A project will be undertaken weekly and more that 200 hours of service will be donated
- The focus is to demonstrate the value of giving back

Conflict Resolution Theme

- Designed to teach anger management skills, mediation and anti-bullying strategies
- The focus is to demonstrate

skills that will empower young men to be successful in school, at home and in the community at large

Business Theme

- Designed to teach the world of business and fiscal management.
- On *Business* day, shirts and ties are the mode of dress when participating in such activities as making bank deposits and having lunch with African-American businessmen.
- The focus is to instill the habit of saving and to teach the young men how to conduct themselves in a business setting.

Just for Fun Theme

- Designed to teach the young men the value of completing tasks and assignments and the rewards associated with completion
- Each week the campers will explore amusement parks and other recreational facilities.
- The focus is to just have fun

Literacy will be addressed by the young men reading articles and stories regarding the day's theme. Math will focus on financial literacy, counting and managing money. Additionally a personal trainer will assist with fitness. The young men will experience chess, swimming, and martial arts.
